


"The staff knows who we are as individuals and that we still are part of society, and we do belong. This is the best place that they could have put us, it is a lot better than a shelter. "

Your Support Helped Us to Grow Our Mission

2020 is indelibly etched into the fabric of SHOW because it forced all of us to consider what it means to have a home. A place of refuge, a workspace, a place to protect us from the ravages of a deadly virus, a place where we could keep each other safe.

With your support, we adhered to our mission to ensure that vulnerable individuals would continue to be housed. As a result, 144 Erb Street East became our third affordable housing building. During a worldwide crisis, you stepped up so SHOW could step in to provide stability and security to those most at risk, ensuring that those tenants would continue to enjoy stable, affordable housing. Donor support, alongside the support of both the City of Waterloo and the Region of Waterloo enabled us to provide the down payment and fund the important upgrades in the building. Beyond that, our friends at The Kitchener Waterloo Community Foundation played an important role in making our purchase possible.

The Board of Directors has nurtured an environment that can balance both the support needs of our more vulnerable tenants with a plan to grow our housing portfolio and have spent 2020 developing those systems for our future.

Outdoor physical activities helped our tenants and many in the community enjoy yoga, tai chi and more, volunteers dropped off treats, and we were able to give tablets to tenants so that they would be more connected.

In all these activities, we were diligent in protecting our tenants and staff and are proud to report we did not have a single case of COVID. And donors, like you, made it possible for us to safely engage and connect with tenants to tackle the social isolation so many of us felt this year.

SHOW is about having a home, about ensuring that all in our community can live in dignity. It is a privilege to serve this agency. As we look to 2021 and beyond, we are grateful to count you as a continued supporter. With you by our sides, SHOW will continue to embrace changes and challenges but will stay true to its mission of providing safe, affordable, and supportive housing to the community.
